What does it cost?

Each parent or carer signs in. Mobile phones are tucked away until going home time. The session starts with children AND carers singing and playing in music-based activities.

This is followed by free play with all the toys in the wheelie box, until going-home time at 11.00 am. While all activities are under the watchful eye of volunteers, parents and carers are always responsible for the children in their care.
